Ethical Code

Members of the academic community:

- 1. develop the intellectual, emotional, social and moral side of each person,
- 2. create, support and maintain a suitable teaching environment,
- 3. continue their education, improve their professional skills and participate in the development of the school,
- 4. cooperate with colleagues and other professionals in the interest of education,
- 5. respect and protect the right to privacy and copyright, do not engage in unethical and fraudulent conduct,
- 6. not abuse their position, not cover up unethical behavior for the purpose of their own or others' benefit,
- 7. adhere to the ideals of democracy and, in this spirit, contribute to the development of society as a whole,
- 8. approach their profession as a mission, and are capable of critical self-reflection,
- 9. are people of integrity, ensure the efficient and effective use of the provided funds,
- 10. communicate in an open and fair manner, are fair and apply equal treatment to all,
- 11. keep in mind the reputation of their alma mater.

Violation of the principles of the UCC Ethical Code will be resolved within the Disciplinary Committee and a sanction may be imposed in accordance with the UCC Disciplinary Rules, which are part of the approved and registered internal regulations.
