

ERASMUS+ SOJOURN – STUDYING ABROAD

(DIRECTIVE OF THE VICE RECTOR FOR STUDIES)

1. This directive regulates conditions for applicants interested in a study mobility abroad from students of Prague school of creative communication (hereby „PSCC“).
2. Study mobilities (including the grant) are guaranteed for PSCC by the consortium: *Educa International, o.p.s.*
3. Study mobilities are realised as one-semester study at the partner institution abroad.
4. The list of partner institution (including specifications) is accessible to look at in the corresponding section on the PSCC website (**Annex of the directive no. 1**).
5. To be eligible for a study mobility, the student must be duly enrolled in any bachelor degree programme and must also pass:

- An interview regarding the students motivation for studying abroad:
 - Max. 50 points

Bonus points (for recognition the student must support their application with the documents:

- Significant award (+ 15 points)
 - Charity project / work for a nonprofit organization (+ 15 points)
 - *AMIGO Program* (+ 10 points per student): www.vskk.cz/cz/student/program-amigo/
 - Active participation at school events / work for *Kreativní Kancl* (+ max. 10 points)
6. To apply for the selection proceedings the student needs to fill out a corresponding form (**Annex to the directive no. 2**)
 7. The application are to be sent by the applicant to: erasmus.studium@vskk.cz.
 8. Students who fulfil the condition set out by the selection proceedings are nominated for the Erasmus+ sojourn. Nominations do not establish an automatic claim for the student to be given the Erasmus+ funding.
 9. Required documents needed before the start of the study mobility (administered by the partner institution and consortium):
 - a. **Learning Agreement**
 - b. **Student's declaration about ensuring healthcare insurance and liability insurance.**
 - c. **Erasmus+ participant's agreement for student mobility.**
